RESOLUTION NO. 2020-019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADY, TEXAS, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-001 ORDERING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 2, 2020 SAID DATE BEING A UNIFORM ELECTION DATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILLING POSITIONS OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE ONE; APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICIALS; SETTING THE RATE OF PAY FOR ELECTION OFFICIALS; ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ELECTION CLERKS; VOTING BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE; PROVIDING FOR CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL AND CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; SEVERABILITY; PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING; AND EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brady, Texas passed Resolution No. 2020-001 Ordering a General Election to be held on May 2, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, the Governor of Texas, due to COVID-19, issued a Proclamation to allow political subdivisions to move their general and special elections for 2020 to the next uniform election date occurring on November 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2020, the City Council of the City of Brady passed Resolution 2020-010 moving the election date to November 3, 2020;

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2020, the Governor of Texas issued a Proclamation to expand the early voting period for the November 3, 2020 elections;

WHEREAS, the City of Brady is required to update their Election Order and Notice of Election reflecting the new dates for early voting in the November 3, 2020 election.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Council of the City of Brady hereby Orders the General Election to be held on November 3, 2020 for the purpose of electing Mayor and Council Member for Place One (1).

SECTION 2: That the City Council of the City of Brady hereby confirms that the dates for early voting shall be October 13, 2020 thru October 30, 2020, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with extended hours from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on October 15, 2020 and October 27, 2020 at the office of the County Clerk, 101 N. High Street, Brady Texas; Early Voting Clerk, Christine A. Jones.

SECTION 3: The polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3, 2020

("Election Day"). The polling places for the election on Election Day shall be as follows:
